Ysgol Treffynnon - Year 6 school-based induction days

We are very much looking forward to welcoming your child into Ysgol Treffynnon on **Monday 24th June 2024 and Tuesday 25th June 2024** for the annual Year 6 school-based induction days.

The two induction days will run as follows:

Day 1 – Monday 24th June 2024	
8.30 - 8.40	Students to arrive at school at Tennis courts and escorted to the Sports Hall
8.45 - 9.00	Assembly with R Chesters – students to be given their form groups
9.00 – 9.15	Form time with tutors and form class [cashless catering registration]
9.15 - 10.00	Form time with tutors and form class
10.00 – 10.35	Break time [packed lunch or purchase food from canteen]
10.35 – 11.35	Form time with tutors and form class
11.35 – 12.15	Taster lesson
12.15 – 1.10	Lunch time [packed lunch or purchase food from canteen]
1.10 – 2.10	Taster lesson
2.10 – 3.00	Taster lesson
3.00	End of the school day – parents collect children or escorted to the bus park if necessary

Day 2 – Tuesday 25th June 2024	
8.30 - 8.40	Students to arrive at the school and meet in the school atrium/canteen area
8.45 - 9.15	Form time registration with tutors and form class
9.15 - 10.00	Form time with tutors and form class
10.00 – 10.35	Break time [packed lunch or purchase food from canteen]
10.35 – 11.35	Taster lesson
11.35 – 12.15	Taster lesson
12.15 – 1.10	Lunch time [packed lunch or purchase food from canteen]
1.10 – 2.10	Taster lesson
2.10 – 3.00	Form time with tutors and form class
3.00	End of the school day – parents collect children or escorted to the bus park if necessary

Students will leave school at the end of each day via our student entrance which is located around the back of the school. Please collect you child from the bus park at

the very bottom of the Strand Road [the old bus rather than our current bus park] as you will not have access to the current bus park in your car.

During the school-based transition days, Year 6 children will be able to travel to school on the school buses. If you have any queries about this then please contact the school.

Year 6 children will also be able to access and join the school's breakfast club each morning. Breakfast club takes place in Food Technology room on the first floor and starts at 7.45am until 8.30pm. It is free to all children.

Canteen Arrangements

All children will be set up on the school's cashless canteen system [with their biometric fingerprint] on Monday 24th June 2024. Your child will either need to bring a small amount of money to put on the re-valve machine [your child will be helped with this] or parents can put money on your child's account via the school gateway app.

All children will be provided with a free school meal on both transition days, due to their primary school entitlement. This will be up to value of £3.05 each day. If your child spends any more than this during the day, please ensure that your child's account is credited via the school gateway app or with money in school, in order to cover the cost. Your child can also bring a packed lunch with them if they prefer.
